

Pour chaque leçon:

- Découper les étiquettes correspondant à la structure étudiée; coller au dos du scotch aimanté; placer les étiquettes au tableau le temps de l'étude de cette structure.

- Puis, à chaque séance d'étude de la structure:

- Mélanger les étiquettes:

- un élève vient remettre les étiquettes en ordre (put the labels back in order) puis en collectif (all together) les élèves disent la phrase;

- les élèves récrivent la phrase correcte sur leur ardoise (write the right sentence on your slate).

- Présenter au tableau les étiquettes en ordre; les élèves ferment les yeux (close your eyes) ou se retournent (turn around); l'enseignant retire une étiquette. Demander:

- à un élève de redire la phrase complète (can anyone say the whole sentence again), puis la redire en collectif ;

- à l'ensemble de la classe d'écrire le mot manquant sur l'ardoise (what word is missing? what is missing? write it on your slate).

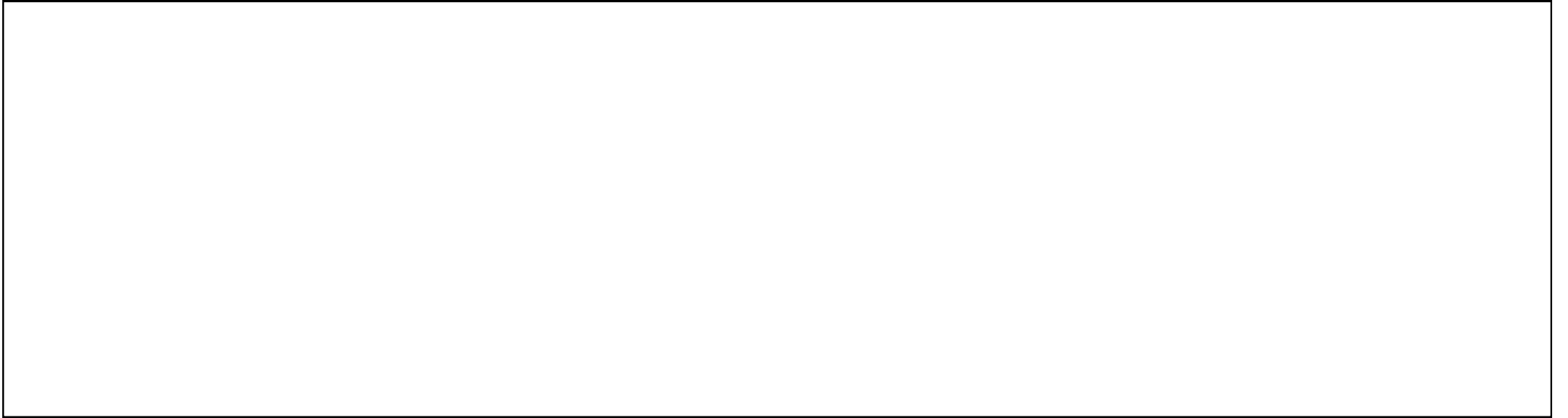
